Committee Meeting Minutes of Meeting held on Monday 15th January 2018 at City Hall

- 1. Introduction: Dave welcomed everyone and outlined the agenda for the meeting. He announced that Blanche Cameron was stepping down from the group due to other commitments. The group were very appreciative of her help over many years.
- **2. Minutes:** The minutes of the 16th October 2017 were approved and the draft minutes of the General Meeting of the 4th December 2017 were noted.
- 3. Matters Arising: Item 8 Wandsworth Council had submitted an appeal. Item 11 The World Urban Park's Congress was not well attended but was of a high quality and inspiring. Dave had led the Community Empowerment Workshop. Item 14 Westminster Conference 30 people attended and Dave was a speaker and it was a positive meeting. The LFGN meeting on the 4th December had a good discussion about Biodiversity. Richard outlined the issues with Large Events in Parks and encouraged people with concerns to contact him via contact@victoriaparkfg.co.uk. It was felt a further sub group could be formed to concentrate on Parks under Threat.
- **4. Communications:** Adrian and Kerry had set up a new web site www.lfgn.org.uk and have updated the Twitter (@LDNgreenspaces) and Facebook (LFGN Friends of Greenspace Network) sites. It was agreed Adrian will set up a Mailchimp account to communicate more effectively with our members. These should help us to keep members informed in particular if there is a crisis that needs our support. 9 responses from the survey had been received and they were being analysed.
- **5. Our Space:** This project by CPRE is nearly fully funded (£5k) and Dave has suggested to Alice Roberts it should be hosted on our web site. It will be launched on 26th January from 4 to 6 at 70 Cowcross Street. The key suggestions are:
 - a. Monthly Newsletter
 - b. Use our web site to host the newsletters
 - c. Organise 2 annual events
 - d. Organise visits to parks
 - e. A database of non-friends groups (i.e. residents groups etc.)
 - f. Put people in touch with similar issues.
- **6. GLA Community Consultation Conference:** 20th January 2018. City Hall 9.30 to 5.
- **7. Government 25 Year Plan:** National Federation to respond.
- **8. Charter**: national organisations have now taken to the Charter and once a few more organisations have signed it will be launched in time for the Local Elections in May.

- **9. Parks Action Group**: Lordship Rec is the venue for the first meeting on 22nd January of the group which will include civil servants and Friends' Groups. It is not clear if the new minister for Parks Rishi Sunak MP will attend.
- **10. Local Elections**: Parks for London and CPRE are planning a range of activities for the Election. Haringey Parks Forum has written parts. Dave to chase the distribution of this.
- 11. London National Park City: 29 wards are left before a majority have signed up.
- **12. Borough Reviews:** members to be persuaded to scrutinise their parks and work towards Fields in Trust objectives. The Hounslow survey to be used as a template. 19 surveys received based on the Haringey model. Survey Monkey to be used for surveys on the web site.
