## What

## Ownership

Is the green space privately owned or does it belong to the council?



## Which

Which habitats do you want to nurture, support or create?

Why do you want to create these habitats?



## Contact

Talk to the landowner or contractors about your ideas to seek approval?

Arrange a joint site visit to discuss ideas



## Call out

Recruit volunteers to support and help carry out the tasks, explain, publicise events and issue a press release

# IN YOUR GREEN SPACE



## Who

Do you have local people in your group that have knowledge about biodiversity?



## Survey

What biodiversity has been found so far?

What species could be attracted?



## Where

Which areas of your green space are calling out for creation or enhancement of habitat?



## Support

Engage wider park-user community (e.g. public meeting or opinion surveys).

Firm up ideas and get permission. Think about funding, volunteers, equipment and liability insurance for work days.



## Publicise

Use social media, emails and interpretation boards.

Hold a celebration event annually thereafter.
